About the Ichthys Project

The Ichthys Project is a Joint Venture between INPEX Browse Ltd (76%, the Operator) and Total E&P Australia (24%). Gas from the Ichthys Field, in the Browse Basin offshore of Western Australia, will undergo preliminary processing offshore to remove water and raw liquids, including condensate. This condensate will be pumped to a floating production, storage and offtake facility anchored nearby, from which it will be transferred to tankers for export to overseas markets.

The gas will be transported through a pipeline approximately 885 kilometres long to the proposed onshore LNG processing plant on Blaydin Point, Darwin.

The Ichthys Project will have an initial capacity to produce 8.4 million tonnes of LNG and approximately 1.6 million tonnes of liquefied petroleum gas per annum, as well as 100,000 barrels of condensate per day at peak.
