## **CYCLONE CONTINGENCY PLAN - MEMBRANE CARRIER INFORMATION**

Instructions for Vessel's Master and appointed Local Agent:

- This Form needs to be sent during Wet Season (01st November 30th April).
- At least 24 hours prior arrival, membrane carriers must submit this form to Ichthys Terminal at <a href="mailto:DLOnshoreMarineTerminal@inpex.com.au">DLOnshoreMarineTerminal@inpex.com.au</a> via vessels appointed agent. (Only Column "A" to be completed)
- When Darwin Port has issued a cyclone 'Advice' warning, vessel masters must, in addition to above complete **Column "B"** at commencement of loading and then every **3 hours** until departure, submit this form to Darwin Port at <a href="mailto:membranetankers@darwinport.com.au">membranetankers@darwinport.com.au</a> via vessels appointed agent, keeping the Terminal in copy.
