Employment Information

JKC is constructing the Ichthys Project LNG plant and onshore facilities for INPEX. If you are interested in employment during the construction phase of the Project please register your details with JKC, and not INPEX.

How can I register my interest with JKC?

You must provide your employment qualifications and experience on-line, by either uploading relevant documents to the jobs website (www.ichthysjobs.com), or on the computers available at the Construction Employment and Mobilisation Centre (CEMC) located at 22 Mitchell Street, Darwin.

Before doing so, you must have electronic versions of the files you wish to upload – hard copy applications cannot be accepted.

If you experience difficulties during the uploading process you can contact 08 8980 9999 for further help.

What happens to this information?

Your information is automatically entered into the Project's "Registration of Interest" database. Once you have completed the registration process you will receive an email from JKC confirming your success.

What happens then?

A wide variety of roles will be required over the Project's 5-year construction phase. JKC's subcontractors, who are responsible for the various packages of work, will access the database to select appropriate candidates for consideration.

The phasing of the various packages means that some time may go by before candidates who have registered are contacted for work. We ask for your patience if this occurs.

Construction Activities

Construction activities expected at JKC construction sites this week include:

Blaydin Point

- Continuing heavy rock transport using up to 14 trucks per day from DAC Howard West quarry (Yarrowonga) to the Blaydin Point site via Jenkins Road
- Smaller rock will soon begin to be transported from Yebna Quarry south of Jenkins Road
- Operations include 2 shifts working 10-hrs per shift, with maintenance performed between each shift
- Wickham Point Road intersection upgrade continues.

Howard Springs Accommodation Village

Monday to Saturday:

- Mulching activities have now been completed
- Installation of groundwater monitors
- Construction hours continue 6.30am-5.30pm
- Construction of an on-site water storage designed to significantly reduce reliance on external water supplies for dust suppression
- Commenced delivery of accommodation modules
- Ongoing site preparation and top soil removal Sundays (from July 15)
- Construction hours restricted to 9am to 5pm
- Construction activity will be managed to ensure most occurs on the Howard Springs Road side of the construction site, to minimise impacts on nearby residents

Appropriate dust suppression will be in place, and noise and dust impacts will continue to be monitored across both construction sites.
