

This week JKC Australia LNG Pty Ltd (JKC) advises that construction activities at the Howard Springs Accommodation Village and at the onshore LNG facilities at Blaydin Point will include:

Blaydin Point

- Ongoing ground improvements for the Module Offloading Facility (MOF) causeway and construction of MOF through the mangroves
- Heavy rock transport by 18 trucks per day from DAC Howard West quarry (Yarrowonga) via Jenkins Road to Blaydin Point site
- Small rock transport by 10 trucks per day from Yebna quarry south of Jenkins Road to Blaydin Point site
- Two trucks per day transporting crushed rock from Mt Bunday quarry to the concrete batching plant on Channel Island Road
- Six trucks per day transporting concrete from a batching plant on Channel Island Road to Blaydin Point site
- Nine water trucks per day accessing Paspaley's Pond, off Channel Island Road, to Blaydin Point site

- Operation of two shifts working 10 hours per shift, with maintenance performed between each shift
- Wickham Point Road intersection upgrade is expected to be completed in November

Howard Springs Accommodation Village

- Ongoing construction of sewerage headworks linking into the Palmerston sewerage system including:
 - Continuation of pipeline work along Howard Springs Road
 - Removal of a fence to allow for excavation activities to commence at the Stow Road pump station site
 - Revegetation of the pump station site, along Stow Road, to commence in November
- Ongoing steel erection and installation of roofing and cladding of central facilities

- Transporting of the next shipment of accommodation modules to site from 29 October through to 6 November
- Ongoing site preparation and construction activities
- Construction hours from 7am to 6pm – Sunday construction hours are restricted to 9am to 5pm

Appropriate dust suppression and street sweeping measures are in place at both sites, and noise, dust and road conditions will continue to be monitored across all JKC construction sites.

Commencement of Channel Island Road and Chung Wah Terrace intersection upgrade



From Monday 29 October, local company East Arm Civil will commence the upgrade to the existing Channel Island Road and Chung Wah Terrace intersection in Palmerston, to improve traffic conditions for the safety of all road users. This work is under the direction of JKC Australia LNG and is expected to be completed in February 2012, weather permitting.

The improvements will include:

- Additional left turn lane from Chung Wah Terrace onto Channel Island Road
- Extension of northbound right turn lane on Channel Island Road to Chung Wah Terrace
- Additional northbound through lane on Channel Island Road
- Improved southbound left turn on Channel Island Road to Chung Wah Terrace
- New street lighting and improvements to current drainage structures

Construction activities will include:

- Mobilisation of equipment and establishment of site – road

signage in compliance with Australian standards

- Site survey and pegging
- Clear and grade
- Intersection construction
- Lighting installation

To minimise disruption to the community:

- No road closures will take place, however, some changed traffic conditions will be necessary
- Expected hours of operation are from 6:30am to 5:30 pm from Monday to Saturday
- The location will be monitored for any potential community impacts during the construction period. JKC welcomes community feedback so that appropriate changes can be put in place
- Appropriate dust suppression will occur and noise and dust monitoring will be in place
